

NIST INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL FEES: 2017 – 2018 ACADEMIC YEAR

All fees and figures are in Thai baht (THB)

Application Fee: 6,000

The application fee is *non-refundable*. This payment must be submitted at the same time that the application is made to the Admissions Department. Submitting an application to the school does not guarantee a space for a student. The Admissions Committee will review all applications.

Assessment Fee: 2,500

The assessment fee is *non-refundable* and must be paid at the time of assessment. The Admissions Committee makes the decision whether or not a student is eligible to take an assessment test.

Registration Fee: 265,000

This fee is *non-refundable* and must be paid upon acceptance for entry to the school. This is a one-time fee.

Campus Development Fee

Parents must select either (1) or (2) from the following:

Option (1): A **575,000** campus development deposit (CDD) to the Campus Development Fund, which is *refundable* within 45 days of withdrawal of each student, net of any outstanding bills for tuition or other fees.

Option (2): An annual payment of **55,000** to the Campus Development Fund is an alternative to the CDD. This annual fee is *non-refundable* and must be paid each academic year.

Re-enrollment Security Fee (Returning Families)

A 55,000 security fee per child is required each year at the time of re-enrollment, around March. The fee secures a place for the following school year, and it is offset against the first semester's tuition fee. However, if re-enrollment is confirmed and the student(s) does not take their placement, this fee becomes non-refundable.

Families who have paid the CDD of 575,000 are *not* required to pay the re-enrollment security fee. However, families who have paid the CDD and confirm re-enrolment, but do not take the placement, will have 55,000 deducted from the CDD.

Diploma Examination Fee: Approximately 36,000

In addition to the fees above, all year 13 students are required to pay all applicable IB Diploma Programme fees. This includes registration for the diploma or certificate, as well as for every subject that each DP (Year 13) student sits. There are also courier and administration costs for the internal assessments and for each examination.

Conditions & Payment Schedule

EAL is offered in addition to, alongside and within the regular programme in select year levels. The principal goal of the EAL programme is to help students acquire sufficient competence in English to succeed in their studies at levels comparable to those of their non-EAL peers. The programme therefore provides essential support to students from non-English speaking backgrounds. Furthermore, it is compulsory for those students who the school deems in need. *It is not an option in such cases. However, in line with our school's values, we do not charge an extra fee for any EAL support.*

The annual due dates for each semester's fees are fixed. In cases in which these dates fall on public holidays or weekends, fees are due on the next business day. *Please note that overdue payments incur a 1.25% per month surcharge, and all fees must be paid before a student can attend school.*

For the 2017-2018 school year, 2 July is a Sunday, and 1 December falls on a normal business day. Payments are due on these fixed dates:	Semester 1	Semester 2

Refund Policy

Once fees have been paid, there will be no refund provided for students leaving the school before the end of a semester.

Late Entry

Tuition fees will be pro-rated for students joining NIST after the school year has started. The percentage of the full fee charge will be dependent upon the date of entry to the school:

Optional Activities & Expenses

During the year there are other optional activities which students may wish to participate in both within Thailand and abroad. Parental approval is sought for each of these activities, and each of the activities selected will be invoiced separately. These activities may include, but are not limited to, activities such as tennis lessons, instrumental music lessons, gymnastics club, Duke of Edinburgh's Award, summer school, international SEASAC sports competitions, or arts competitions and workshops.

Community Languages Programme Fees

Some Language A options at NIST are provided through the Community Languages Programme (CLP). In order to support families who wish to maintain or develop a mother tongue that is not offered at NIST, the languages in the CLP are taught by tutors and organized by community language groups. These languages are offered at an additional fee that is billed with the regular tuition fees. If your child or children opts to enroll in the programme, this fee will be applicable. The annual due dates for each semester's fees are fixed with the school tuition fee. *Please note that once the CLP fees have been paid, there will be no refund provided for students leaving the school before the end of a semester.*
